The teachers at Christ Church Ware School, who requested that they not receive gifts from pupils but rather a donation was made to the Foodbank instead

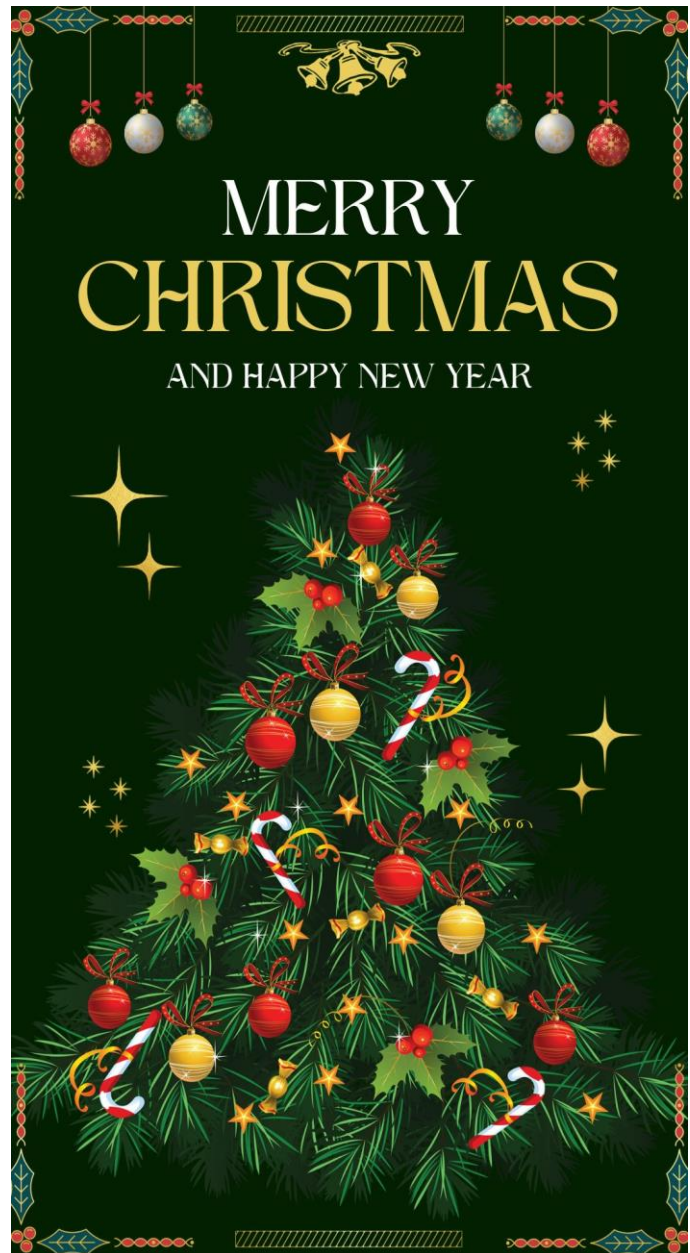
The many individuals who created and donated reverse advent calendar hampers
